Public task for the purposes specified in Personal Data (see our website), in accordance with the legal basis of Public task: collecting the data is necessary to perform tasks that colleges are required to perform as part of their statutory function.

Vital interests to keep you safe (food allergies, or medical conditions)

Legal obligation data collected for DFE census and the data of alumni to report on the progression of students into employment and additional educational courses

Legitimate Interest informing alumni of relevant progression opportunities which may support their educational or career objectives.
